## **Criminal justice response to cyberCRIME ≠ cybersecurity**

- Aimed at protecting security and c.i.a and other rights of people
- Procedural law safeguards to prevent abuse
- De-escalate threat of conflict

## **Instruments and tools against cybercrime are already available**

(Budapest Convention on cybercrime and many others)

= Full implementation most pragmatic and effective way ahead!

## **Core problem**

- Limited understanding / interest / priority at leadership levels
- Lack of capacities in many (developing) countries to implement / make use of what is already available

## **Need**

- Enhanced capacity building through development cooperation: measures against cybercrime ► security, rule of law, human rights, democracy, good governance [What is the approach of the World Bank and others?]
- Monitoring/review progress made by countries
